Hello United,

Transitions can be tricky and tough, let alone transition during a worldwide pandemic. Therefore, I'm happy I have gotten to know a lot of our church family this past year. Many of you may be more familiar with Brett's background than mine. So, let me share a little snapshot of my history. After graduating from the University of Northwestern with a degree in Liberal Arts and Bible, I worked on staff at First Presbyterian Church of Strasburg in Pennsylvania as the Director of Student Ministries. As I felt led by God to focus on working alongside folks affected with disability, I resigned from that position. When Brett took over that role, I continued as a volunteer with the student ministry. From there I went on to craft a "Disability Sunday" at the church and create a respite program for children and families affected by disability. I worked in multiple Special Education classrooms before moving to New Jersey for Brett to attend seminary. While in seminary I had the privilege to work as a research assistant studying how children who are nonverbal communicate joy. Needless to say, I enjoy working with children and youth and enjoy even more sharing the love of Christ with them.

I'm thankful I can serve in this way while the Personnel Committee continues their search to fill this role long term. I'll still be continuing my work with the Presbyterian Mission Agency and working on the coffee business.

From the Pastor...



UPC family, it's June and the weather is beautiful here in the Twin Ports. We just had our first good rain and thunderstorm of the season last night. As someone who is patiently waiting and hoping for a good harvest through our local farms for my family's Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) box of veggies, fruit, and bread, I am ever so thankful. Did you know a CSA drops off at the church every week? If you want more info on that just give our office a call.

As we move into the warmer months your church is serving, refreshing and planning for the future. Many of you all know the Hotdish Initiative continues to grow in the amount of people we serve as well as its capacity to feed families. A huge thank you to Joan Johnson who has stepped up and shared her cooking prowess with this important ministry. Your Mission Committee has met and decided to augment the mission dinner ministry to fit the current situation and care for our community in one of the best ways we've known how. On the third Sunday in July, we will be hosting our first Community "takeout" where we prepare hot meals in compostable to-go containers. Families will be able to use our homemade "drive-thru" to get a nice warm meal. In the church, we've cleaned out offices, made new ones, moved some things around and refreshed spaces. On top of that, the Worship Committee and Session, after receiving overwhelming positive response to the ability to watch services online, worked with a consultant to discern if live-streaming services was a possibility for us going forward. After receiving a bid, and discussing it at Worship and Session, it was approved. We will have the capability of recording and live streaming going forward. It will also improve our current services as soon as the new tech gets in place. We also haven't forgot those folks who do not have internet either. With this new technology, we will be able to burn DVD's of the service for distribution to anyone who could benefit from it. Your Session also decided at that meeting to create a new committee of Session, the Technology Committee. They will be responsible for all of the audio and visual technology on our campus. They will also oversee our entire online presence from our social media to our website.

I know that there are a lot of questions about how church will happen and what community and fellowship could be like going forward with the reality of Covid-19. The Worship Committee and Session have set out a task force including a healthcare professional dedicated to devising a strategy, alongside guidance from church councils as well as local, state, and federal officials about how we can continue adapting. Be on the lookout for communication from them.

I long for the day when we can connect and worship in person again and I can see you all. For now connecting means joining us on YouTube for worship, on Zoom for Coffee Breaks, and seeing you all when we are on runs through town.
