From the Pastor...



United, when you get this letter take a moment to sit down, close your eyes, take a deep long breath and hold it for a few seconds, then exhale slowly. Open your eyes. Sometimes I take moments to just consciously breathe and it helps the peace that God promises to us set in. Over the past few weeks I've witnessed a lot of death, anxiety, and terrible circumstances for so many folks here in this community and around the world. I've also witnessed a community come together in some incredible ways. I've witnessed moments of joy, togetherness, and beauty. The current situation in the world contains multitudes. That is, there are both terrible things and things of beauty that are happening simultaneously during this pandemic.

Here are a few things of beauty I want to lift up: Our "Hotdish Initiative" is going strong. A huge thank you to Christy Willmore, Jane Wester, Kate Lisak, Nick Long, and Dawn Long who have faithfully been making all of these meals and organizing them. A huge thank you also to all of you as well as folks in the community. Because of your contributions we funded the first hotdish and quite a bit of the second. Already, we've easily fed over 100 families in Superior and Duluth and while that is such a small number, we've received numerous thanks indicating that each one of those meals made a world of difference in the life of some of these families. On top of that, masks continue to be made. If you need a mask and do not have one, many have been made to be distributed by us at the church. Call the church office Monday-Friday 12-4 or email Julie to get one for you or your entire family, free of charge. Thank you United, for being the hands and feet of Christ to a community and world that is hurting. Your efforts in these trying moments are protecting people and changing lives. If you need any assistance do not hesitate to reach out to the church.

Your church continues its important work and I am excited for all that God is doing through us right now. After receiving such positive feedback, the Worship Committee is working on making worship accessible online even after we are allowed to meet together again. The Mission Committee has revived and revamped an initiative to literally help rebuild people's homes here in Superior and Duluth. Your Finance Committee has been diligently working and was approved and received the PPP Grant/Loan as well as a waiver from the Board of Pensions of the PC(USA). All of the other committees and Session continue their important work as well.

While much ministry continues to happen, I do long for the day that we can meet together in worship again and I suspect you do as well. I want to share with you all this verse that has been on my mind, Philippians 1:3-6: "I thank my God every time I remember you, constantly praying with joy in every one of my prayers for all of you, because of your sharing in the gospel from the first day until now. I am confident of this, that the one who began a good work among you will bring it to completion by the day of Jesus Christ." God is at work and I hope to see you soon.
