

From the Pastor...



Family, so much has changed in so little time. We literally went from prepping for Holy week and our Easter service to cancelling, postponing, or digitally transferring everything that took place at our church's campus. Now we are learning how to care for our neighbors, put together faithful online worship, and do ministry in a world that asks us to meet through screens. I am at a loss for words besides, "Wow." Thank you UPC for navigating these quickly changing waters with us as a church.

While your church is in the middle of this public health crisis with you it is actively discerning and acting on ways to reach out and care for the community. From sewing medical masks to a Hotdish initiative feeding many families here in the Twin Ports we continue to be the hands and feet of Jesus even when we have to be 6 feet apart. God's love not only embraces healthy social distancing but creates ways in which people can feel loved, accepted, and cared for in the midst of it all.

Though much has been cancelled on our calendar we will still be commemorating Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, and Easter on the days that they normally occur in several different ways online. However, just like FaceTime isn't the same as actually visiting with family, Holy Week and Easter just don't feel the same online as they do in person. Last week, I mentioned that ways of doing certain things were dying all around us. Well, in the midst of all that death, eventually, there will be resurrection. Your worship committee along with session has decided that we will celebrate Maundy Thursday and Easter Sunday as a church during the first full week we are allowed to be back together in person for worship. We will gather together to eat as Marian Lanigan will still be hosting and organizing our Easter breakfast (please stay tuned for a sign-up genius), we will sing songs of the resurrection, we will acknowledge that neither COVID-19 nor death have the final say for this community.

In the midst of the uncertainty concerning when restrictions will be lessened and when we shall be able to meet face to face together again, I want to leave you this month with the words of Psalm 27:13-14 as encouragement: "I believe that I shall see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living. Wait for the Lord; be strong, and let your heart take courage; wait for the Lord!"
