



From the Pastor...



UPC Family, Happy New Year! Thank you for allowing me to lead and share in this past Advent and Christmas season with you. To me they were quite special in all of their antics and holy moments. I will always cherish my "first" Christmas as a pastor. As the year 2019 ends, I have been reflecting and praying about what the year 2020 might mean for us here at UPC.

To look forward appropriately, I believe, you must reflect on the past. Looking back, as a child, I never in my wildest dreams could imagine what life would be like in the year 2020. In the past decade much has changed in my life. I have completed 3 different degrees, been married, adopted a dog, and moved several times among other things.
